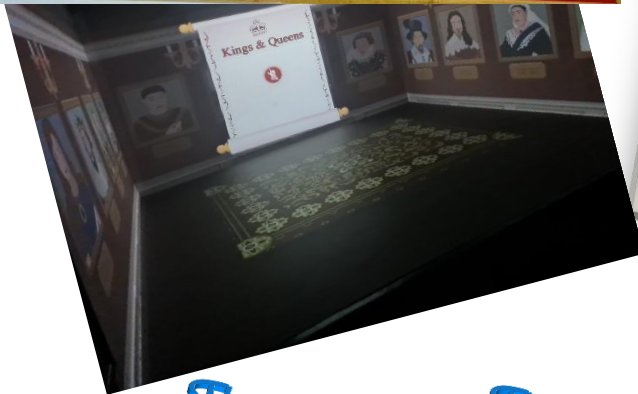


Twinkle House Summer Newsletter 2022
